

CMKC/KUMC Joint Research/Clinical Pediatric Fellowship (two year fellowship)

The integrated Department of Pediatrics at Children's Mercy Kansas City and the University of Kansas Medical Center invites applications for a two-year postdoctoral pediatric psychology fellowship for the 2019-2021 academic years. The objective of the fellowship is to prepare the doctoral level trainee for an academically oriented career in pediatric psychology. The fellowship provides opportunity for clinical and research experiences across our faculty of more than 70 child clinical and pediatric psychologists. Given the main faculty involved in this position, the ideal candidate will have a primary focus on one of three pediatric populations: 1) endocrine/diabetes, 2) pain management, and 3) weight management. However, we encourage applicants to tailor the fellowship to fit their clinical and research interests and needs. During the two-year postdoctoral fellowship, the time spent on clinical care, research and education is somewhat flexible, but will provide sufficient hours to support clinical licensure.

HOW TO APPLY TO THE FELLOWSHIP:

This fellowship uses the APPIC Psychology Postdoctoral Application Centralized Application System (APPA CAS) for submission of applications. Applicants may access information on the electronic submission process at <https://portal.appicpostdoc.org> or the Association of Psychology Postdoctoral and Internship Centers (APPIC) website at www.appic.org.

To apply, please submit the following documents via the APPA Centralized Application System by November 25, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. Central Daylight Time: 1) A letter of interest identifying the position of interest, your qualifications, specific clinical and/or research interests, and goals for the postdoctoral training year (maximum two pages). 2) Curriculum vitae; 3) Clinical writing sample; for applicants to the CM/KU joint research position, please also include a research sample, and 4) Three letters of recommendation submitted directly from your recommenders (at least two from supervisors familiar with your clinical work).

This postdoctoral psychology fellowship program follows the recommended APPIC Postdoctoral Selection Guidelines. In addition to the APPIC Postdoctoral Program Directory, descriptions of available positions will be posted on the listserv for APA members of Division 53 and Division 54. All qualified applications will be reviewed with invitation for on-site interviews being issued no later than December 30th, 2017. On-site interviews, although subject to change, are expected to be held between January 21st and February 1st of 2019. Offers will be extended on the uniform notification date of February 25, 2019, as recommended by the APPIC Postdoctoral Selection Guidelines. Applicants will be notified as soon as they are no longer under consideration and when all positions are filled.
